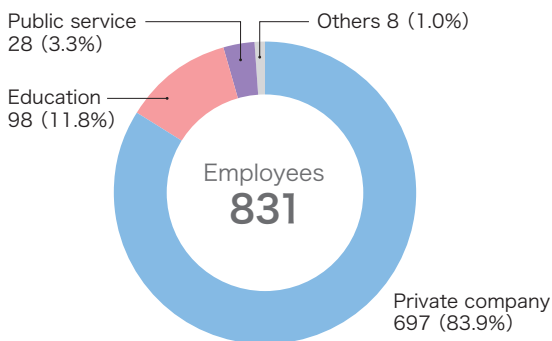

Restructuring of Undergraduate Programs

A new undergraduate curriculum beginning in 2025

To nurture individuals capable of collaborating with diverse groups in a rapidly changing and unpredictable society, Okayama University will launch a new integrated undergraduate program in 2025. The existing General Education and Major Courses will be reorganized into General Education Courses, English Language Courses, and Major Courses to create a four-year (or six-year) integrated undergraduate program.



Art of Collaboration in Research

Interdisciplinary Learning Across Schools and Departments

Starting in AY2025, a new course titled "Art of Collaboration in Research" will be introduced as a General Education Courses for all first year students. This course bridges the concepts of "inquiry" from high school and "research" at the university level. Taught by active researchers, it provides first year students with opportunities to collaborate on group projects, developing essential skills like teamwork, project management, and effective communication.

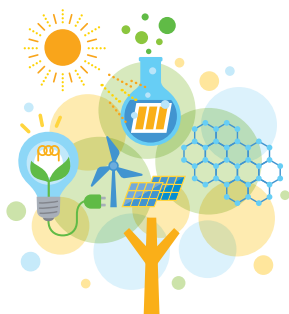




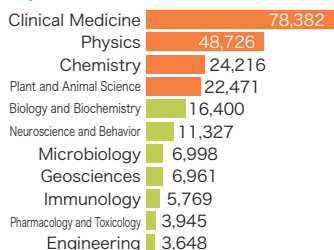
Transforming Society with Research The Challenge of Okayama University

Okayama University has been selected for the Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology's J-PEAKS project (5.5 billion yen), which aims to develop research universities driving nationwide research development. The goal of Okayama University is to build on its world-class research, which is recognized in Japan, to contribute to global-scale innovation. Centered around the Institute for Advanced Cutting-edge Research and the Organization for Research and Innovation Strategy, Okayama University will promote:

1. the elucidation of the mechanism of natural photosynthesis and the creation of clean energy through implementation of artificial photosynthesis;
2. a society that supports the well-being of all generations, particularly in the face of a declining birthrate and an aging population, through expertise drawn from national strategic special zones and academic research; and,
3. the development of the human resources, research infrastructure, and financial strategy to empower a research university that will revitalize Japan.

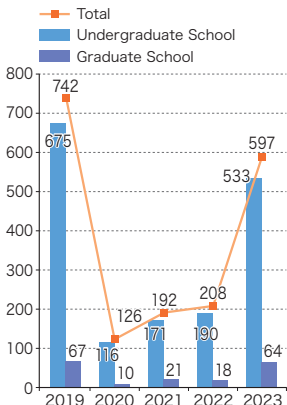
DISTRIBUTION OF INTERNATIONAL PARTNERS

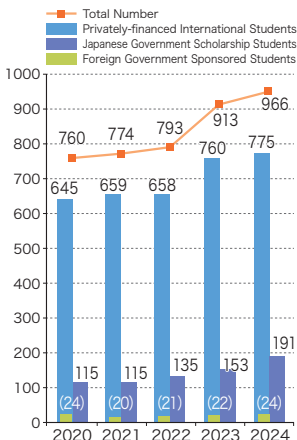

HOSPITAL AND LIBRARY

OKAYAMA UNIVERSITY HOSPITAL offers state-of-the-art medical care, research and education systems.

OKAYAMA UNIVERSITY LIBRARIES boast large collections with a total of approximately **1.96 million volumes**

OKAYAMA UNIVERSITY HOSPITAL

- Among the best university hospitals in western Japan, with 853 beds and 50 departments (38 medical and 12 dental departments)
- Average daily number of patients: 2,679 (553 inpatients and 2,126 outpatients)
- Annual number of surgeries: 9,557
- Okayama University Hospital provides state-of-the-art medical care such as organ transplantation, pediatric heart surgery, minimally invasive endoscopic surgery and robot assisted surgery. The hospital is the only one in the Chugoku and Shikoku regions with authorization as a Core Clinical Research Hospital, Translational Research Center (TRC) and a Cancer Genome Medicine Core Hospital, and is the clinical research base in Western Japan.

The hospital maintains a high matching rate in the employment of residents, and also carries out the mission as an educational institution, providing clinical training to many foreign physicians.



OKAYAMA UNIVERSITY LIBRARIES

- The University Libraries consist of the Central Library, the Shikata Branch Library, and the Institute of Plant Science and Resources Branch Library. They provide approximately 1,960,000 books and boast **the largest collection of books in Okayama Prefecture**.
- Their wide range of services extend to local communities and other educational institutions. They provide publications of approximately **88,000 e-journals**, **31 databases**, and publish the academic research achievements of OKAYAMA UNIVERSITY. They work to promote functional enhancement of online services, and to support research and learning activities.
- The Central Library houses the Ikeda Family Collection "**Ikedake Bunko**" which contains records and documents of the Ikeda clan, the feudal lords of Okayama from 1632 to 1871. The collection consists of an archive of about 100,000 legislative documents, Japanese classics, and Chinese classics. The collection is well known as a source of primary materials for research on the Shogunate government and clan governments during the Edo period.

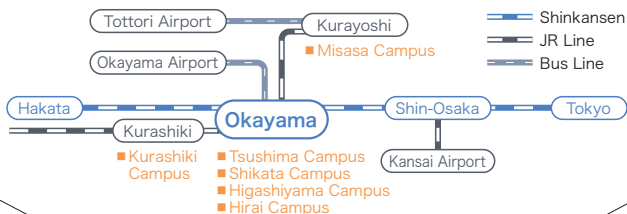
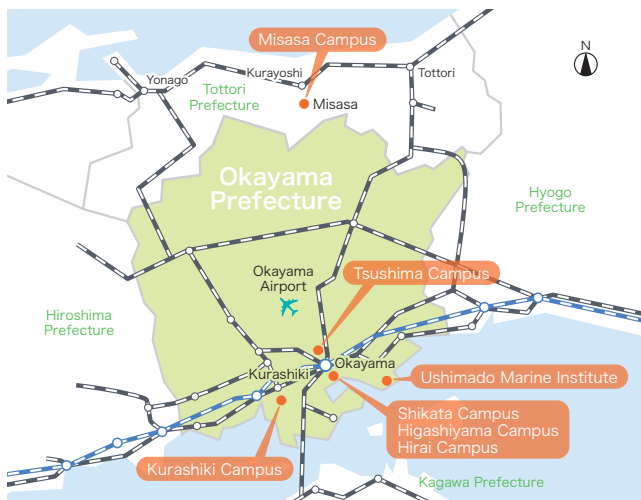
