MJCP 田中医療奨学金のご案内

認定非営利活動法人日本・ミャンマー医療人育成支援協会（MJCP）はミャンマーの医療・医学の向上を目的に2005年に設立され、会員のボランティアにより活動を行っている非営利団体です。しかし、新型コロナウイルス世界的流行とミャンマー国軍のクーデターによって、その活動は停滞しています。また、それらの影響で現在日本に滞在し、帰国が困難となっているミャンマー人が多数に上っています。MJCPは、これら帰国困難となっている医療・医学に関与、また今後関与しようと考えているミャンマー人を対象に故田中茂人理事のご遺族からの寄付を基金とした奨学金制度を設けました。

対象となる人

1. 留学継続希望者 現在日本に留学中で、これまで受けていた奨学金の減少・停止、本国からの送金の途絶、その他の理由により生活困難となっているミャンマー籍の医療人・医療関係者。年間3人程度募集。
2. 新規医療人希望者 現在日本に滞在中で、医療・医学に関与していないが、現在の滞在目標を変更して医療・医学を習得するための教育機関に入学を目指すミャンマー国籍の人。年間3-5人程度募集。

給付の条件

1. 留学継続希望者は、履歴書、推薦状と給付希望の理由書を提出ください。書類審査と面接により給付額を決定します。
2. 新規医療人希望者は、履歴書、推薦状と給付希望の理由書を提出下さい。現在の在留資格の変更が可能か否かの審査を行った後に、書類審査と面接により給付額を決定します。

給付の内容 いずれも返済義務はありません。

1. 留学継続希望者には、月額5万～10万円の額
2. 新規医療人希望者には、新しい職に携わるために必要な教育機関への授業料、および生活費として月額5万～10万円の額

説明

- ・8人程度を限度とした宿舎（冷暖房、シャワー、トイレ、台所あり）の利用も可能です。
- ・いずれも留学残余期間、全就学期間給付しますが、年度ごとに審査を行い継続不能と査定された場合は給付を打ち切ります。他の奨学金との併用は認めますが、減額となる場合もあります。ミャンマーの情勢が正常化し、MJCPの活動も復帰した場合、新規採用は停止しますが、既採用者については採用期間終了まで継続します。
- ・教育機関は、医歯薬学科系、保健学科系の大学（院）、看護・介護・リハビリ学科系の専門学校またはそれぞれの入学に必要とされる日本語学力習得のための日本語学校です。
- ・必要教育を終えた人の日本での就職は職種により可能ですが、得られた知識・技術は将来的にはミャンマーの医療・医学の向上に役立ててください。

Myanmar-Japan Collaboration Project for Fostering Medical Human Resources (MJCP), an Approved Specified Nonprofit Corporation founded in 2005, aims to enhance healthcare and medical education in Myanmar. All activities of MJCP are performed by voluntary members. However, the ongoing global pandemic of COVID-19 and the military coup in Myanmar have not only thwarted all our planned activities in Myanmar, but also had immeasurable impact on the daily lives of Myanmar people residing in Japan.

Considering the hardships of those people who are having difficulty returning home, MJCP has established a scholarship fund to financially support those who are (or are planning to be) involved in healthcare or medical fields. This scholarship fund is based on a donation made by the bereaved family of the late Dr. Shigeto Tanaka, our member of the Board of Directors.

Eligibility:

1 Those who wish to continue their present studies in Japan: Myanmar medical or other healthcare professionals who are currently studying in Japan, and experiencing difficulties in their lives due to a decrease or suspension of their scholarships, disruption of remittance from their family, or other reasons.

No. of recipients: Approx. 3 persons per year

2 Those who wish to start their studies in healthcare/medical fields: Myanmar nationals who are currently residing in Japan and are not involved in healthcare/medical services, but wish to change their current goals and enroll in one of the educational institutions to start their studies in healthcare and medical fields.

No. of recipients: 3 to 5 persons per year

Requirements:

1 Those who wish to continue their studies in Japan: Submit a curriculum vitae/C.V. , a recommendation letter, and a statement of reasons for scholarship application. The amount of Scholarship will be determined based on the submitted documents and an interview.

2 Those who wish to start their studies in healthcare/medical fields: Submit a curriculum vitae/C.V. , a recommendation letter from a reference person, and a statement of reasons for scholarship application. The possibility of changing their current status of residence (to "Student" status) will be confirmed before determining the eligibility of the Scholarship.

Amount of Scholarship (Grant-type):

1 Those who wish to continue their studies in Japan: 50,000~100,000 yen per month

2 Those who wish to start their studies in healthcare/medical services: Tuition fees for the new educational institution necessary to engage in a healthcare/medical profession, in addition to 50,000~100,000 yen per month for living expenses

Terms and Conditions:

- Accommodation (equipped with an air conditioner, shower, toilet and kitchen) for up to 8 persons is available.
- Either scholarship will be paid for the remainder of or the whole study period; however, the scholarship qualification is subject to yearly review and will be suspended if considered incapable of continuing.
- The Scholarship may be used in conjunction with other scholarships, but the amount may be reduced.
- When the situation in Myanmar is stabilized and MJCP resumes its originally planned activities, new recruitments will be suspended but existing recipients will continue to receive the scholarship until the end of their scholarship period.
- “The educational institution” includes universities and graduate schools of medicine, dentistry, pharmaceutical sciences and health sciences, vocational schools of nursing, elderly care and rehabilitation, and Japanese Language school to acquire Japanese language skills required for admission to the above-mentioned educational institution.
- After completion of your study, it is possible to get a job in Japan depending on the job type; however, the recipients are expected to use their knowledge and techniques acquired through their education for the advancement of healthcare and medical sciences in Myanmar in the future.
